Comments from the Editors and Reviewers:

Although your manuscript falls within the aim and scope of this journal, it is being declined due to lack of sufficient novelty. We receive a much larger number of papers than we are able to accept.

In its current state, the level of English throughout your manuscript does not meet the journal's required standard. You may wish to ask a native speaker to check your manuscript for grammar, style and syntax, or use the professional language editing options available from Elsevier Author Services: https://webshop.elsevier.com/

We regret to tell you we were not able to find the required number of reviewers to evaluate your manuscript; we don't want to delay the process for you any longer.

The research results reported are too premature for publication. More work is needed to substantiate the conclusions in your manuscript.

While the paper has potential, in its present form it lacks coherence and focus.

The paper needs extensive re-working.

Many of the figures and data don't describe the EV market and its potential for growth.

It also doesn't distinguish between aggregate transport statistics and individual behaviors.

Factor such cost (greatly affected by subsidies) both for purchase but also operations and maintenance need to be better discussed.

Moreover the availability of necessary infrastructure to support charging and operations of EV as well as trip distances and purposes need to be integrated into the analyses and decision-making.

The sampling also needs to be better justified, especially for EV owners and users which are not adequately represented.

The policy implications and contributions for researchers should be described.

The TPB model needs to be better explained. It seems that cost, convenience, other attributes associated with vehicle purchases are not sufficiently covered nor explained.


